Cicada Lodge

Cicada Lodge, a small private sanctuary from which to embrace the ancient landscapes of Nitmiluk Gorge and Indigenous culture within the iconic Nitmiluk National Park. The lodge is designed for the sophisticated traveller looking for an authentic Indigenous and natural "experience of a lifetime" in the heart of Australia's timeless north. Nitmiluk Gorge is the centrepiece of Nitmiluk National Park, and comprises a system of 13 immense gorges carved over the millennia by the Katherine River through the ancient stone country of the region. More than a location of beautiful landscapes, the gorges hold great cultural value for the Jawoyn people. For these traditional owners, Nitmiluk refers to a cicada dreaming place – the place where the spirits of creation abide.



Eco-accredited Indigenous guides run the Gorge cruises and tours, providing commentary on the region and sharing their knowledge of the local flora and fauna.
